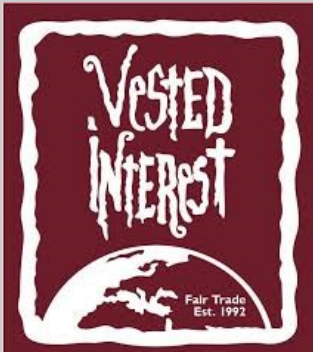

Glen DeVuono Memorial Award

This past August we lost a great Chamber supporter and former secretary-manager of the North Bay & District Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Glen DeVuono was the secretary-manager for 33 years (1966 to 1999).

The current executive and board of the Chamber of Commerce implemented a memorial award in Glen's honour for Community Builder.

Back in the day, a young entrepreneur came forward to join the board of directors and was a great asset for 10 years on the board; he was elected President in 1986. While 20 years his junior, Glen became fast friends with this young entrepreneur and community champion.

Victor is known for his early days in business with Sahara Advertising, Fedeli Advertising and then after he sold his business, he became instrumental in a number of not-for-profits earning only a \$1 per year for his efforts with the Nipissing University Business Centre, Canadore College Aviation Campus and the infamous Air Base Property Corp, saving the air side assets of the base for private enterprise. We all know the story of more recent years: Mayor of the City of North Bay, MPP for Nipissing and his most recent posting as the Honourable Minister of Finance. Congratulations Victor.

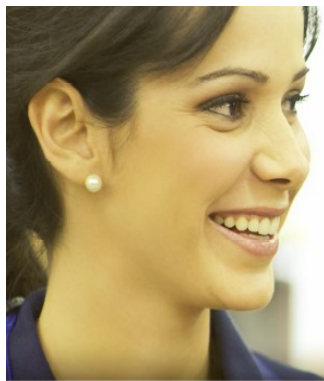

The City of North Bay is pleased to introduce bids&tenders™ as their new eProcurement platform and will be joining hundreds of other purchasing organizations in posting their bid opportunities exclusively on bids&tenders™. The City of North Bay will transition to using bids&tenders™ in two phases; starting November 6th as part of Phase 1, all bid opportunities will be posted on bids&tenders™ for viewing and downloading. Submission of bids will continue to be in-person and by mail courier.

Phase 2 Implementation in early 2019 features electronic submission of all bids. This provides the following additional features:

- Automated confirmation when your bid has been submitted, received, or withdrawn.
- Ability to work on a bid, save your work, and see the bid-closing countdown in real time.
- Ability to withdraw and change your bid, then resubmit if desired.
- Built-in calculator that does the math for you – no need to worry about math errors.
- Built-in compliancy checker – so you know your bid is compliant before you submit.
- Built-in reminders sent to you if a bid has been started but not submitted.
- 100% electronic submission.

At the evening of excellence Judy Kleinhaus and Mitchell Crown of Grant Thornton presented the **Not-for-Profit of the Year** award to **KidSport North Bay**.

KidSport North Bay was established in 2002 to assist kids in sport with registration and equipment fees. Since their partnerships with Nipissing Lakers Hockey in 2009 and then with the North Bay Battalion in 2013 with 50/50 sales, their programs have expanded to cover more sports as possible. Since it's inception year of assisting 35 to 50 children per year, they have been able to increase their assistance over the past 5 years to on average of 350 children per year. This has been tremendous support to families and children in 18 different sports and activities in the area.



Business of the Year

This year's winner was **AMJ Campbell Van Lines North Bay-Sudbury**. Dave and Virginia Willms have managed both locations for the past 30 years, and in June 2017 purchased the branches. AMJ Campbell is also the largest division of Atlas Van Lines Canada with more than 38 locations coast-to-coast. AMJ Campbell North Bay has been awarded numerous national awards for quality and customer service over the years. As the North Bay-Sudbury location has grown, a new division was added and the Willms are happy to now be affiliated with AMJ Campbell Self-Storage with two locations (Carmichael Drive and Callander Bay Drive). They are now in their second expansion in two years of a new heated self-storage and 2,000 sq ft warehouse.

Gymtrix was incorporated in 1998 and moved to their large current location on Ferris Drive in 2010, when Tim Mills joined the partnership of Nicki Chretien and Bill Rhoads.

Nicki and Bill are professional coaches and Gymtrix is recognized locally, provincially and nationally as a leader in their industry. Over the past 20 years, tens of thousands of children and adults - from those with profound special needs to elite athletes have trained and thrived at Gymtrix. Gymtrix Sunshine Classic, one of the largest gymnastics/trampoline invitational competitions in Ontario, is also celebrating 20 years. The inaugural event in 1999 saw 300 participants and is now over 800 athletes in 2018.
